**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2008-03
FIRST AMENDMENT**

IN RE: PRIVATE APPOINTED COUNSEL: EXTRAORDINARY RATES

WHEREAS, Section 27.5304(12)(b), Florida Statutes, requires the Chief Judge or a designee to hold an evidentiary hearing on motions to exceed the statutory limits in extraordinary and unusual cases; and

WHEREAS, by Administrative Order 2008-03, dated February 1, 2008, the clerk of court in the county in which any motion for extraordinary fees is filed is directed to immediately forward the motion to the Chief Judge for disposition; and

WHEREAS, for purposes of judicial economy, it is appropriate to designate a judge in the criminal division to address these motions.

THEREFORE, effective immediately, it is **ORDERED** that:

1. Circuit Judge James C. Hankinson is hereby designated to hear all motions for extraordinary fees or costs pursuant to Section 27.5304(12)(b), Florida Statutes.
2. The respective clerks of court shall immediately forward a copy of any such motion for extraordinary fees and costs to Judge Hankinson at his Tallahassee office.
3. Except as herein expressly amended, Administrative Order 2008-03 shall remain in full force and effect.
