**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2020-10
SECOND AMENDMENT**

IN RE: CIRCUIT AND COUNTY JUDGE ASSIGNMENTS

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 2020-10, In Re: Circuit Judge and County Judge Assignments, as amended, currently sets forth the assignments for the judges of the Second Judicial Circuit of Florida; and

WHEREAS, Rule 2.215(b)(4), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, provides that the Chief Judge shall assign judges to the courts and divisions and shall determine the length of each assignment, it is therefore

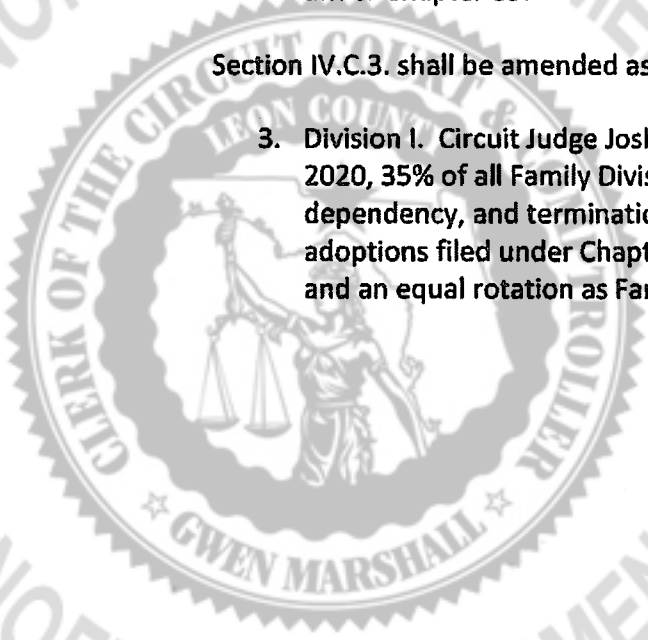
ORDERED that the following amendments to Administrative Order 2020-10 shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until modified by subsequent order:

Section IV.C.1. shall be amended as follows:

1. Division G. Circuit Judge Anthony Miller shall be assigned, effective November 5, 2020, all matters under Chapter 39, including juvenile dependency and termination of parental rights, all Unified Family Court Section cases as defined and identified pursuant to Administrative Order 2013-08, adoption cases (excluding uncontested adoptions filed under Chapter 63), two protective injunction dockets per month, and an equal rotation as Family Division Duty Judge. Chief Judge Jonathan Sjostrom is assigned as back-up for all matters under Chapter 39.

Section IV.C.3. shall be amended as follows:

3. Division I. Circuit Judge Joshua Hawkes shall be assigned, effective November 5, 2020, 35% of all Family Division cases, excluding juvenile delinquency, juvenile dependency, and termination of parental rights cases, and including uncontested adoptions filed under Chapter 63, four protective injunction dockets per month, and an equal rotation as Family Division Duty Judge.



UNOFFICIAL DOCUMENT

Section IV.D.1. shall be amended as follows:


1. Circuit Judge Anthony Miller shall be assigned, effective November 5, 2020, all probate cases, except Baker Act, Marchman Act, and Risk Protection Order proceedings.

Section IV.E.5. shall be amended as follows:

5. Leon County Judge Stefanie M. Morris, upon commission as a judge, shall be assigned 20% of all County Court cases.

County judges are temporarily assigned to supplement circuit court. County judges shall not be assigned to handle contested family law cases or child support cases except in an emergency.
