IN RE: CIRCUIT AND COUNTY JUDGE ASSIGNMENTS

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 2024-04, In re: Circuit and County Judge Assignments, entered on May 3, 2024, sets forth the assignments for the judges of the Second Judicial Circuit; and

WHEREAS, Rule 2.215, Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration, provides that the chief judge shall assign judges to the courts and divisions and determine the length of each assignment along with designating administrative judges to assist in the supervision of the court; and

WHEREAS, Florida Governor Ron DeSantis appointed Honorable Christopher D. Bufano on June 19, 2024 to fill the vacancy on the Second Judicial Circuit, Liberty County Court due to the retirement of Kenneth L. Hosford, it is therefore:


ORDERED that the following amendment is effective June 19, 2024, and shall remain in effect until modified by subsequent order:

Paragraph V.C. LIBERTY COUNTY is amended as follows:

V. LIBERTY COUNTY.

C. County Judge Christopher D. Bufano shall be assigned all county court cases, Florida State Hospital hearings, weekday first appearances, and shall serve as primary backup to the circuit judges.
