SECOND AMENDMENT**

**IN RE: CIRCUIT AND COUNTY JUDGE ASSIGNMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, Administrative Order 2024-04, as amended, In re: Circuit and County Judge Assignments, entered on May 3, 2024, sets forth the assignments for the judges of the Second Judicial Circuit; and

**WHEREAS**, Rule 2.215, Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration, provides that the Chief Judge shall assign judges to the courts and divisions and determine the length of each assignment along with designating administrative judges to assist in the supervision of the court; it is therefore

**ORDERED** that the following amendment is effective November 1, 2024, and shall remain in effect until modified by subsequent order:

**Paragraph IV.A.3. and Paragraph IV.B. are amended as follows:**

**A. CIRCUIT JUDGE ASSIGNMENTS**

**3. Family Division:**

- c. Division I: Family: Circuit Judge Robert R. Wheeler shall be assigned 50% of all family cases.
- d. Division J: Family: Circuit Judge Anthony Miller shall be assigned 50% of all family cases.
- e. Circuit Judge Joshua Hawkes shall be assigned all protective injunction cases.

**B. COUNTY JUDGE ASSIGNMENTS**

- 5. Division SA: Leon County Felony Drug Court cases shall be assigned to Leon County Judge Nina Ashenafi-Richardson.
- 6. Division V: Veterans Treatment Court cases shall be assigned to Leon County Judge Augustus D. Aikens, Jr.
