# Notice of the Collection, Use & Release of Social Security Numbers Pursuant to FS 119.071

FS 119.071(5)(a) requires agencies as defined in FS 119.011 to identify in writing the specific laws that govern the collection, use, or release of social security numbers (SSNs) for each purpose for which the agency collects SSNs, including any authorized exceptions. This list is provided to comply with this mandate.

**Note:** The Clerk of Court is not a state agency when acting as an arm of the judiciary, and court records are not subject to the notice requirement of FS 119.071. Nevertheless, the court section of this notice is provided for your information.
