Order Granting Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records
and Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion Regarding Submission of Documents Under Seal for *In
Camera* Review

This Cause having come before the Court on Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records and Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion Regarding Submission of Documents Under Seal for *In Camera* Review, the Court having reviewed the file, being advised of the parties' agreement, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises:

This is an action for declaratory and injunctive relief, in which Plaintiff seeks to protect from disclosure documents that it contends constitute confidential "trade secrets," pursuant to sections 688.002, 812.081(1)(c), 815.045, and 624.4213, Florida Statutes.

The Court finds:

1. Plaintiff has made the showing required to grant the relief requested as to the documents at issue.
2. The degree, duration and manner of confidentiality ordered herein are no broader than necessary to protect the confidentiality interests that Plaintiff asserts, and that no less restrictive

measures are available to protect the interests set forth in Rule 2.420(c)(9)(A)(ii), Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration.

3. Plaintiff has shown good cause for an order determining that the documents should be held confidential pending further order of this Court.

The Court determines that no party's name shall be confidential and that the progress docket or similar records generated to document activity in this case are not to be confidential.

It is ORDERED and ADJUDGED that:

1. Plaintiff's motion is granted.
2. Plaintiff shall submit the documents to the Court in Chambers and under seal, along with a copy of this order, at least twenty days before the hearing on Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment.
3. Plaintiff shall contemporaneously file and serve a notice that it has tendered the documents as required in paragraph 2, above.
4. Upon such tender, the documents shall be held confidential and shall be available for inspection only by court personnel until further order of this Court.
5. The Clerk of the Court is directed to publish this order in accordance with Rule 2.420(e)(4), Florida Rules of General Practiced and Judicial Administration.
