Subject: **JURY SCAM ALERT**

Date: June 15, 2021

The Leon County Clerk of the Circuit Court and Comptroller's office is warning residents about a telephone scam instructing residents to pay money for missing jury duty.

The caller claims to be an employee of the Clerk and Comptroller tasked with making telephone calls to people who are in contempt of court for missing jury duty. When residents respond, they are greeted by a recording answering as the Leon County Sheriff's Office.

This elaborate scheme is one of many, which are threatening residents with heavy fines or jail time.

We caution citizens to beware of unsolicited telephone calls or suspicious emails. The Clerk and Comptroller's office does not make unsolicited telephone calls regarding jury duty.

If you are targeted for a scam, do not provide any personal or financial information. You are encouraged to report it to your local law enforcement agency.
