ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER: 89-105
AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, there is a need to amend a portion of the
above referenced Administrative Order to insure that Circuit
Court Criminal Division Cases (in Leon County are
proportionately assigned; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to provide computer
programmers with sufficient direction to properly implement this
Administrative Order; it is therefore

ORDERED that:

- A. Section C of Administrative Order 89-105, Re:
Assignment of Leon County Circuit Court, Criminal
Division Cases is hereby amended to read as follows:

" The Clerk of the Court shall implement the
necessary procedures to insure that the two Leon
County Criminal Division Judges are assigned
weighted cases on a proportionate basis. The most
serious charge in each case will be assigned a
numerical weight as specified in Section B. of
this order. The Clerk shall then group the
various weights into categories which
range from the lowest to highest weights.
Assignment of cases in each category
shall alternate between the two
Criminal Division Judges."

- B. All other sections of this Administrative Order
shall remain unchanged by this amendment.
