AMENDMENT

AMENDED ORDER ON NOTICE TO CIVIL INFRACTION WITNESSES

It being made to appear to this court, in correspondence dated January 14, 1992 from Major Robert L. Bull of the Florida Highway Patrol, that his agency, the Tallahassee Police Department and the Leon County Sheriff's Office have implemented a court information sheet for civil traffic infractions that would list the names and addresses of those persons who should be noticed of the pendency of a traffic infraction hearing.

It is the desire of this court that the hearing of civil infraction cases before the court be a meaningful experience and that all who have information relating to such hearings be given an opportunity to be present and testify. It is further the desire of this court, however, to relieve the Office of the Clerk of Court, who is appointed under the provisions of Rule 6.100(a) of the Florida Traffic Court Rules to operate the Traffic Violations Bureau, from any requirement that they research accident reports or otherwise practice law for the purpose of determining who should be noticed as witnesses. It is therefore

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Administrative Order No. 92-01 of this court be amended by the addition of another paragraph as follows:


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, notwithstanding the language of the preceding paragraph, that in any case filed by a local law enforcement agency including therewith a legible list of the names and addresses of prospective witnesses who may be sent notices of the pendency of a hearing before the court, the clerk shall send

notice to that named person at the named address of the style, date, and time of the scheduled hearing.

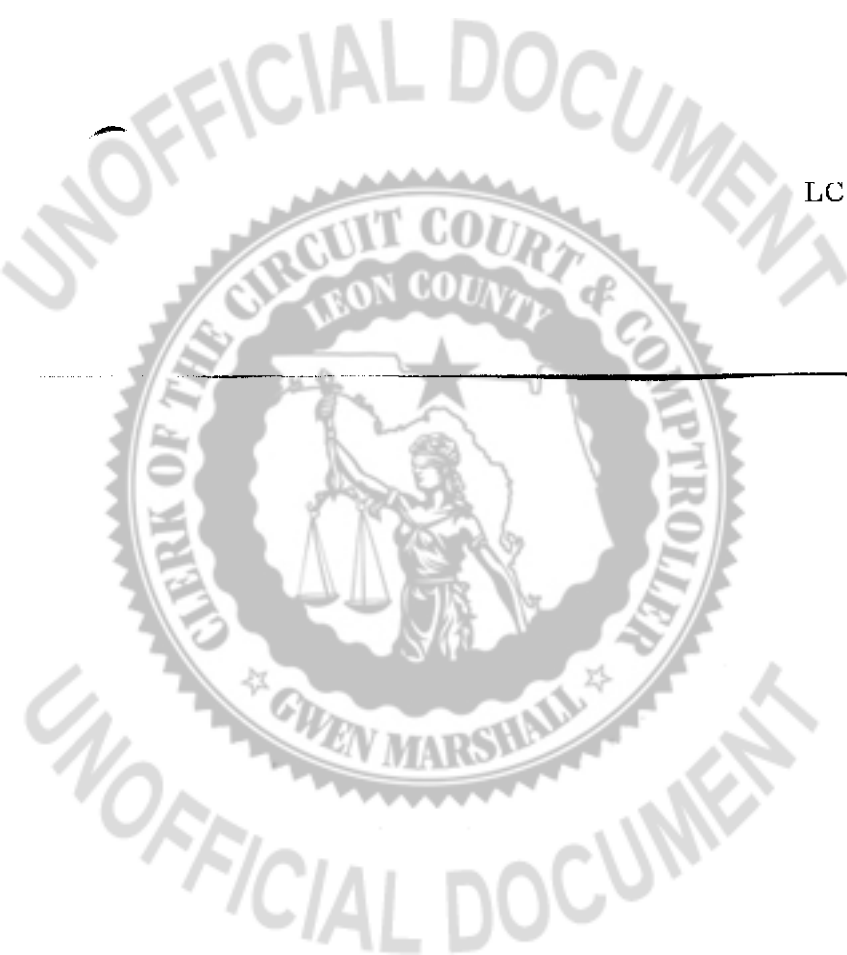
