
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO.91-4

ORDER CLOSING CASES

It has been made to appear to this court that from time to time defendants receive sentences that include incarceration in the Leon County Jail at a future date. When sentence is imposed even though some future acts by defendant are required (such as jail or probation) judicial labors are deemed at end and the case is closed. When a defendant fails to appear at the jail as ordered and a warrant for his/her arrest is issued, each case is thus reopened. When the defendant is arrested and then serves the jail portion of his/her sentence, the case must again be closed. It is therefore

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that after serving the jail sentence, each above case be closed as if the sentence had been properly carried out at the first instance by each defendant, and the clerk is hereby instructed to carry out this order.
