SECOND JUDICIAL CIRCUIT OF FLORIDA

RE: Schools Available to the County Courts, Second Judicial Circuit

This rule is issued as an emergency rule pursuant to action of the Traffic Court Review Committee on July 20, 1979, designating the Big Bend Safety Council as the DWI School for the Second Judicial Circuit, and supercedes all other rules of same subject matter.

Pursuant to action of the Traffic Court Review Committee on July 20, 1979 and in compliance with Florida Rules of Court, 6.110, the Big Bend Safety Council is hereby designated as the DWI School in and for the Second Judicial Circuit.

A transition period through August 20, 1979 is hereby authorized to allow the Big Bend Safety Council and the Apalachee Community Health Services to work out any administrative and operational problems which may exist, except that any offender who is assigned to the DWI School shall be assigned to the Big Bend Safety Council effective immediately.

The schools now available to the County Courts of the Second Judicial Circuit are as follows:

- (A.) Big Bend Safety Council

Tallahassee, Florida
- (B.) Defensive Driving School
1020 E. Lafayette St.
Tallahassee, Florida
- (C.) Tallahassee Memorial Regional Medical Center
Emergency Room, available only to Traffic
Court of Leon County

This rule shall become effective immediately and shall remain in effect until amended or superceded by proper authority.

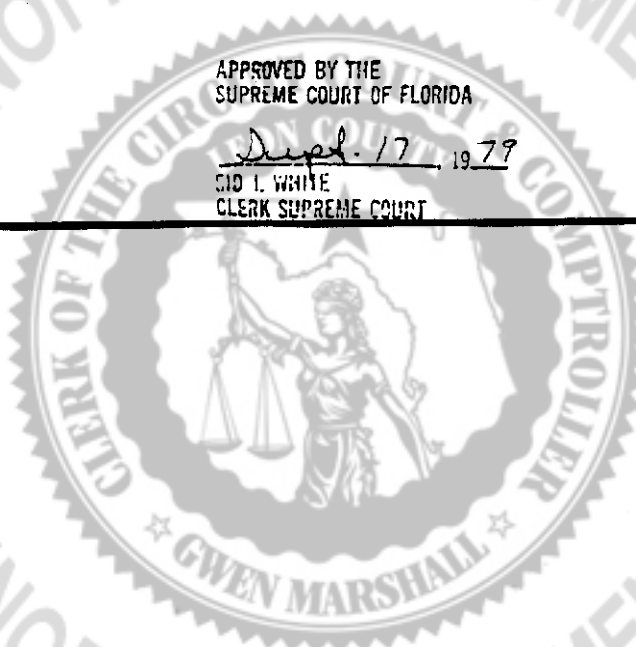
