
IN RE: ISSUANCE OF MARRIAGE LICENSES

ORDER

It appears that Chapter 741, F.S.A. provides that the County Judges have authority in their respective counties to issue marriage licenses and that the issuance of marriage licenses can be delegated to the Clerk of the Court upon proper authorization of the County Judge, and it is therefore:

ORDERED that the Clerk of the County Court, or his duly authorized deputy clerks, be and he is hereby authorized to issue marriage licenses in conformance with Chapter 741 F.S.A.
