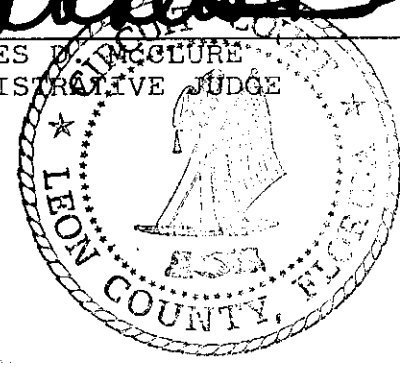
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 3  
CRIMINAL DIVISION

BEGINNING February 5, 1987, Defendants who have been arrested on violation of Circuit Court probation warrants are not to be scheduled for First Appearance in County Court. Said alleged violators, after their arrest, are to be transported from the Leon County Jail directly to the Circuit Judge assigned to the case in the Criminal Division of the Leon County Circuit Court. Said prisoner shall appear before the Circuit Judge at 8:30 A.M. the following morning subsequent to the arrest for arraignment on Monday through Friday. Those Defendants arrested on violation of probation warrants for felonies on Saturdays and Sundays shall be held over and transported to the assigned Circuit Judge the following Monday morning.

At the Arraignment the felony violation of probation defendant will be assigned a violation of probation hearing and an attorney should the appointment be deemed necessary by the court.
