
RE: Possession or Display of Weapons or Firearms in

Effective October 1, 1987, notwithstanding the provisions  
of Chapter 790, Florida Statutes and Committee Substitu  
for House Bill 253 (1987 Florida Legislature), no person other  
than a duly sworn law enforcement officer (as defined in  
tion 943.10 (1), Florida Statutes) or a county or circuit  
judge shall possess or display a weapon or firearm in  
courthouse, courtroom or other judicial facility within the  
Second Judicial Circuit.
