
WHEREAS, the above referenced Administrative Order bans firearms from courthouses in the Second Judicial Circuit with the exception of duly sworn local law enforcement officers; and,

WHEREAS, there is a desire to permit correctional probational officers who have been certified to carry firearms to possess a firearm in a courthouse or judicial facilities in the Second Judicial Circuit, it is therefore,

ORDERED THAT:

Administrative Order 87-77, In Re: Possession or Display of Weapons or Firearms in Courthouses or Judicial Facilities within the Second Judicial Circuit, dated October 1, 1987 and as amended on January 27, 1993, is hereby amended to permit Correctional Probation Officers who work within the Second Judicial Circuit and who have been certified to carry a firearm, to possess a firearm in the courthouses, or other judicial facilities in the Second Judicial Circuit. Such Correctional Probation Officers must identify themselves and provide court security with a photographic identification card prior to being permitted access to secure areas within any court facilities in the Second Judicial Circuit.
