IN RE: Amendment to Administrative Order No. 88-46

WHEREAS, there are reports required at the state level which impact directly on the resources made available by the state to the Second Judicial Circuit to provide for this circuit's efficient functioning,

WHEREAS, these reports have been subject to criticism, to the point of non-acceptance of the provided data, by the Office of the State Courts Administrator and Supreme Court, for use in resource provision decisions,

WHEREAS, these are also critical to the formation of effective data-based management decisions by the Chief Judge and Court Administrator of this circuit,

WHEREAS, there is currently a Delay Reduction Analyst on Leon County payroll, who is available to provide services to the Court which impact on court delay and who has coordinated numerous cooperative, inter-agency projects in the past,

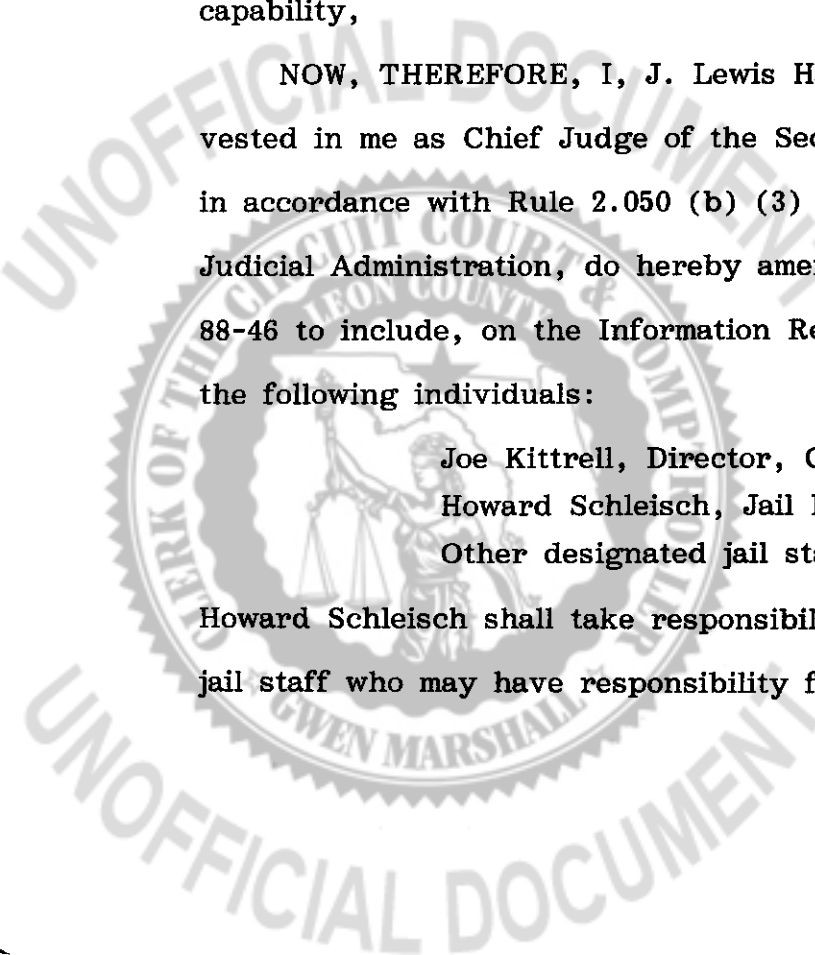
WHEREAS, Leon County data processing services must, necessarily, be centralized and coordinated by a director for the sake of efficiency, and

WHEREAS, Leon County jail staff have input responsibilities/capability,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, J. Lewis Hall, Jr., under authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Second Judicial Circuit of Florida, in accordance with Rule 2.050 (b) (3) and (6), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, do hereby amend Administrative Order No. 88-46 to include, on the Information Resources Management Teams, the following individuals:


- Joe Kittrell, Director, County Data Processing

Howard Schleisch shall take responsibility for designating any other jail staff who may have responsibility for data input related to



criminal data reports.
