THIS CAUSE came before the Court upon a suggestion from the Tallahassee Police Department that more specific identifying data was needed for law enforcement agencies to accurately and thoroughly comply with Orders Sealing or Expunging Criminal Records, and as Florida Rule of Criminal Procedure 3.692(c) provides as follows:

If the petition is granted the court shall enter its order in writing so stating and further setting forth the records and agencies or departments to which it is directed.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Petitions to Seal or Expunge and Orders granting same should include when possible full identifying information so that the law enforcement agencies can accurately and promptly comply with the Orders as follows:

1. Full name of defendant at time of arrest
2. Address at time of arrest
3. Date of birth of defendant
4. Social security number
5. Date of arrest
6. Name of arresting agency
7. Arresting agency case numbers
8. Arrest charges
