IN RE: Creation of Information Resources Management Teams

WHEREAS, there are reports required at the state level which impact directly on the resources made available by the state to the Second Judicial Circuit to provide for this circuit's efficient functioning,

WHEREAS, these reports had previously been criticized by the Office of the State Courts Administrator, acting on behalf of the Supreme Court,

WHEREAS, considerable progress has been made toward improving the quality of these reports through the establishment of information resource management teams,

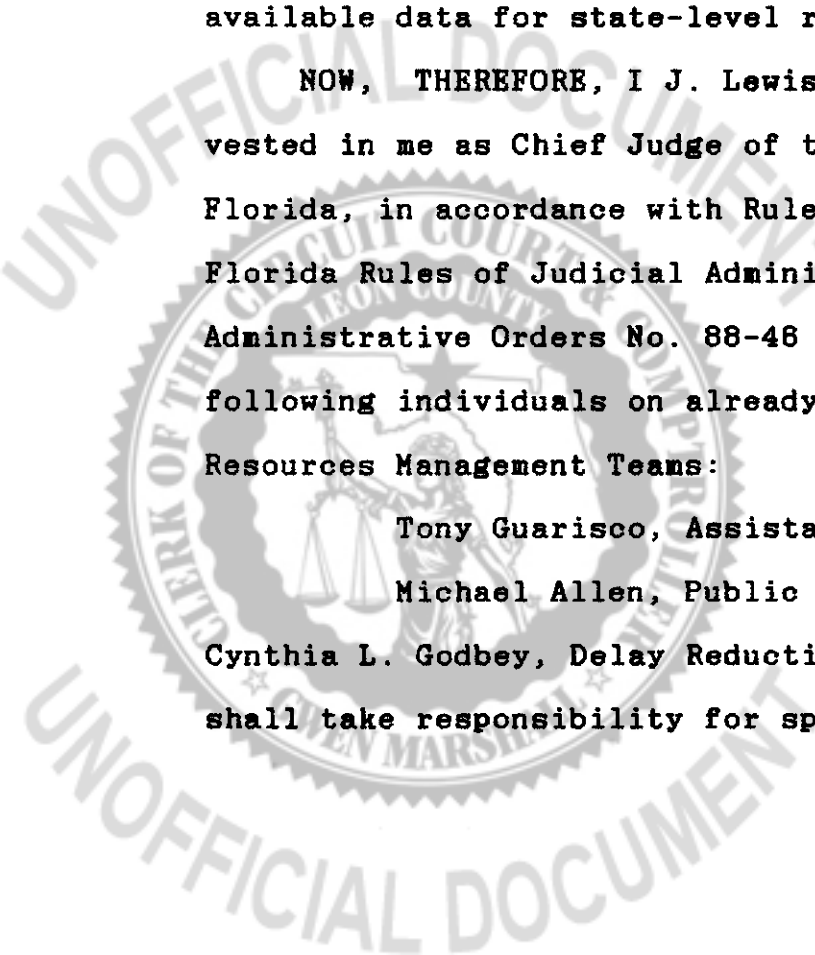
WHEREAS, a primary recommendation made by the jail consultant, Dr. Alan Kalmanoff, stressed the need for reliable data on overall criminal justice system flow and enhanced data processing abilities, and

WHEREAS, participation and planning by all criminal justice system agencies is requisite to accomplishing Dr. Kalmanoff's recommendations and improving the quality of available data for state-level reporting,

NOW, THEREFORE, I J. Lewis Hall, Jr., under authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Second Judicial Circuit of Florida, in accordance with Rule 2.050 (b) (3) and (6), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, do hereby amend Administrative Orders No. 88-46 and 88-47, to include the following individuals on already established Information Resources Management Teams:


- Tony Guarisco, Assistant State Attorney
