
RE: TEMPORARY DESIGNATION OF COURTHOUSE ANNEX,

a temporary branch court of Leon County to transact official

Circuit Court of the Second Circuit during the aforementioned  
dates to hear, consider, and determine any matters in the  
Circuit Court that may be presented.
