**WHEREAS**, Administrative Order No. 89-61, dated July 22, 1989, was established to provide procedures for the handling of Prisoner Petitions; and


**WHEREAS**, there is presently a need to amend one of the provisions of the above referenced Administrative Order; it is therefore,

**ORDERED THAT:**

Paragraph 4 of the above referenced Administrative Order is hereby amended to read as follows:

"The Clerk's Office shall not return any petitions or Affidavits of Insolvency which lack notarization. Pursuant to Section 92.525(2), Florida Statutes, the Clerk's Office may return any Petitions or Affidavits of Insolvency which are not signed by the Petitioner or his counsel, but it is for the Court to decide whether verification of Pleadings and Affidavits is sufficient".
