ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO: 89-81

RE: Temporary Designation of Detention Facility and Courthouse
Annex, Leon County, Florida.

PURSUANT to Chapter 34.181, Florida Statutes and a plan for
mass arrest incidents the following determination is made.

That the location of Ball Field Number 7 at Jim Messer
Field behind the Leon County Jail Annex is designated as an
extension of the Leon County Jail for the purpose of a temporary
detention facility. This will be used to process, detain and
house non violent arrestees in the event a mass arrest situation
occurs. This area is hereby designated as a temporary branch
Court of Leon County to transact official business of the Courts
commencing on October 5, 1989, and continuing until a need no
longer exists.

FURTHER, all first appearances shall replace pre-trial
release activities. Every arrestee shall appear before a
committing magistrate.



FURTHER, any other adjacent ball field, and/or the location
of the Leon County Fairgrounds, South Monroe Street, Tallahassee,
Florida, is hereby designated as the aforementioned.

FURTHER, Judge John Crusoe and any other Judges to be
determined are hereby assigned to the Circuit Court of the Second
Judicial Circuit during the aforementioned dates to hear,
consider, and determine any matters in the Circuit Court that may
be presented.
