


therefore,

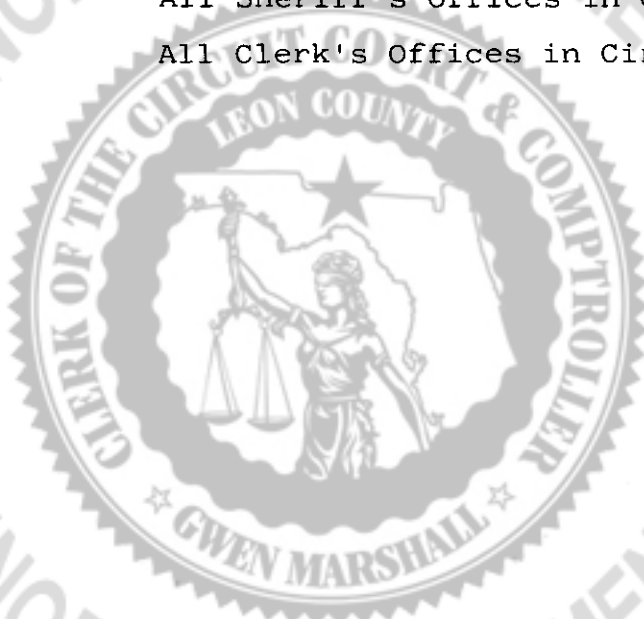
ORDERED, that;
