IN RE: COUNTY COURT JURISDICTION


WHEREAS: The Florida Legislature, during the 1990 session,  
passed legislation to raise the jurisdiction of  
County court case to matters in controversy that  
do not exceed \$10,000, effective October 1,  
and,

WHEREAS: This is a desire to implement this jurisdiction  
change immediately, it is therefore:

ORDERED THAT:

1. Effective immediately, all County Judge's in Franklin, Jefferson, Gadsden, Leon and Wakulla Counties are assigned to the Circuit Court, Civil Division, to preside over Civil cases in which the matter in controversy does not exceed the sum of \$10,000, exclusive of interest, costs and attorney's fees, except those within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Circuit Courts.
2. The Clerk's of the Court in Franklin, Gadsden, Jefferson, Leon and Wakulla are instructed to assign to the appropriate County Court Judge those cases specified in section one (1) above.
3. This assignment of County Judge's to the Circuit Criminal Division shall terminate on October 1, 1990, at which time this jurisdictional change shall become statutorily permanent.
