ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 90-21  
AMENDMENT

IN RE: DESIGNATION OF DRIVER IMPROVEMENT SCHOOL

WHEREAS, Chapter 91-200, Laws of Florida, transfers the oversight responsibility for Driver Improvement Schools from the Chief Judge in the Circuit to the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Second Judicial Circuit, on July 24, 1990, entered Administrative Order 90-21, which provides direction regarding the operation of driver improvement schools in the Second Judicial Circuit; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Judge in the Circuit no longer has the authority to certify driver improvement schools or specify how they shall be operated; it is therefore,

**ORDERED THAT:**

Administrative Order 90-21, in RE: Designation of Driver Improvement School, that was enacted on July 24, 1990, is hereby terminated.
