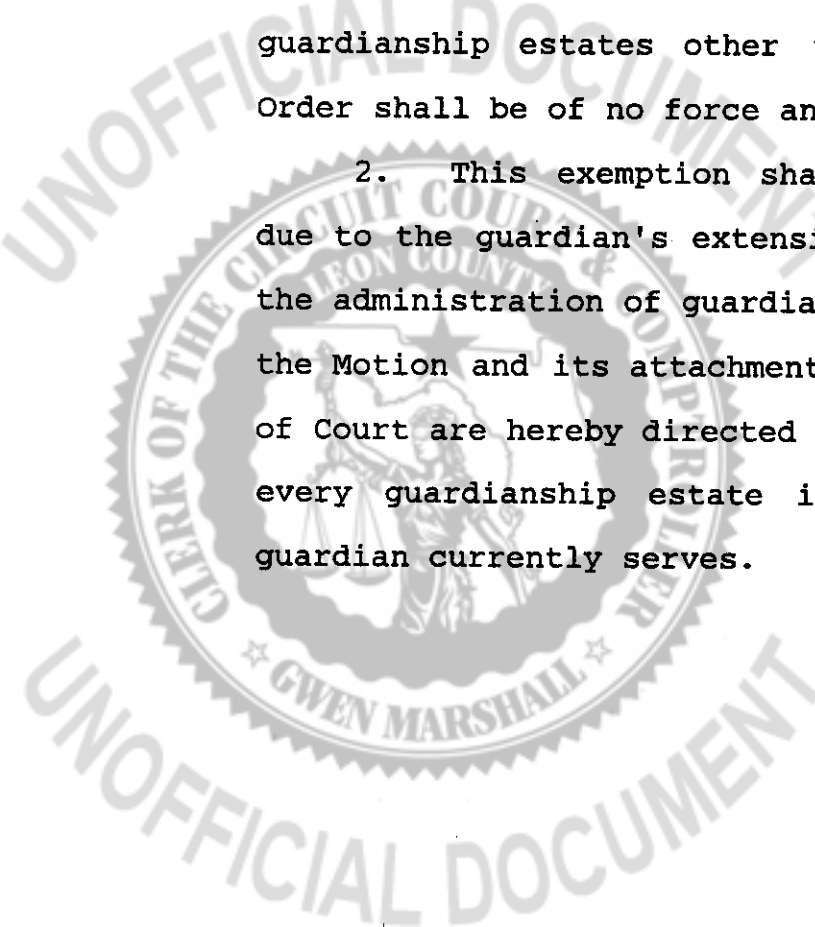
ORDER EXEMPTING PUBLIC GUARDIAN  
FROM EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

THIS CAUSE having come on to be heard upon the Motion of Hugh T. Handley, Public Guardian, Second Judicial Circuit of Florida, for exemption from guardianship educational requirements in all cases in which the said Hugh T. Handley is appointed guardian in his capacity as Public Guardian, it is hereby


ORDERED

1. That Hugh T. Handley shall be exempted from the educational requirements pursuant to Florida Law. This exemption is limited solely to cases in which he is appointed guardian in his capacity as Public Guardian. In the event the above named guardian shall seek appointment to guardianship estates other than as Public Guardian, this Order shall be of no force and effect.

2. This exemption shall be comprehensive in nature due to the guardian's extensive experience and education in the administration of guardianship estates as illustrated in the Motion and its attachments, if any. The various Clerks of Court are hereby directed to file a copy of this Order in every guardianship estate in which the above referenced guardian currently serves.
