RE: COURTHOUSE SECURITY (LEON COUNTY)

Whereas: A security program involving the screening of persons entering the Judges' chambers and courtrooms to detect the presence of weapons has been instituted; and

Whereas: The effectiveness of a court security program is directly related to the thoroughness in which security policies are implemented; and

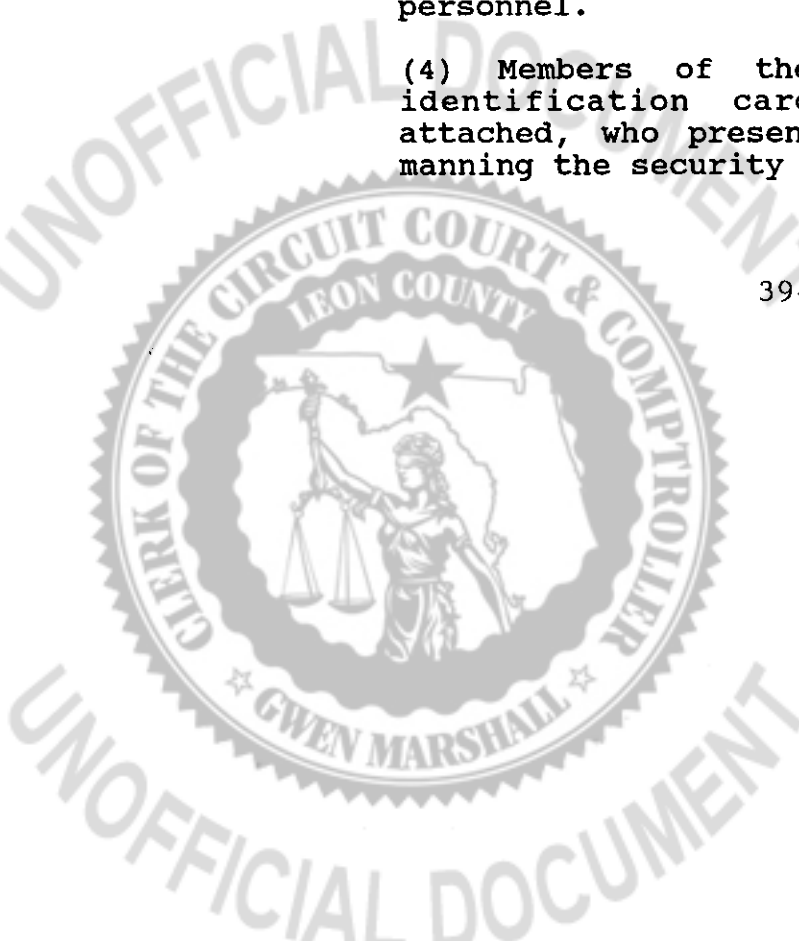
Whereas: There is a desire to exempt members of the local bar from having to be physically screened for weapons; it is therefore:

ORDERED that:

(A) All persons, with the exception of these persons specified in Section B of this order, entering a security area in the Leon County Courthouse shall be physically screened to determine whether that person has a dangerous weapon on his/her person.

(B) Persons exempt from the screening policy set forth in Section A above shall include the following:

- (1) Circuit and County Judges including retired Judges, of the Second Judicial Circuit.
- (2) Law enforcement officers and members of the Leon County Bailiff Unit.
- (3) Staff in the Court Administrator's Office, in the Second Judicial Circuit including: all Official Court Reporters, Public Guardian, Justice Planning and Guardian ad litem program personnel.
- (4) Members of the Florida Bar that have an identification card with a recent photograph attached, who present such a card to the Bailiff manning the security post.




(5) All Judicial employees, including staff from the Public Defender Office, Clerk of the Court, State Attorney, State and local Probation/Parole personnel, that have an authorized identification card shall also be exempt from the weapon screening policy.

(6) Other persons specifically approved by the Chief Judge of the Second Judicial Circuit shall be exempted from the weapon screening policy, upon communication of such exemption to the head of the Leon County Bailiff Unit.
