ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER: 89-113

RE: DOMESTIC VIOLENCE INJUNCTIONS

WHEREAS questions have arisen as to the enforcement of temporary or permanent injunctions in domestic violence cases filed outside the Second Judicial Circuit and where the petitioner is residing within the Second Judicial Circuit in either a permanent or temporary basis;

THEREFORE the following are the procedures to be used in these situations.

1) Petitioner's should register a certified copy of the temporary or permanent injunction with the Sheriff's Department of the county in which they are temporarily or permanently residing.

2) Petitioner should keep a certified copy of the injunction within their possession.

3) All Sheriff's Departments and Police Departments within the Second Judicial Circuit upon proof of a certified copy of the injunction, filed anywhere within the State of Florida; must give full force and effect to the injunction.

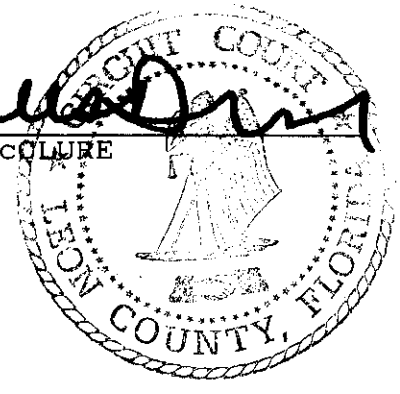
4) In order to facilitate the attendance by petitioners at permanent injunction hearings who do not have their own form of transportation, telephonic hearings are hereby permitted.
