**WHEREAS**, the National Traffic Safety Institute (NTSI) was approved as a provider for basic Driver Improvement classes on July 24, 1990 to become effective on January 1, 1990; and


**WHEREAS**, the Basic Driver Improvement School minimum standards of the Traffic School Review Committee were amended and became effective on November 19, 1990; and

**WHEREAS**, Standard 3.13 states that,"each organization shall be operated by a governmental or non-profit organization...", and

**WHEREAS**, the law firm which represents the NTSI employs a relative of the Chief Judge, Charles D. McClure; as a result, Judge McClure has recused himself in this administrative matter; it is therefore

**ORDERED THAT:** the Honorable F.E. Steinmeyer III, is hereby appointed as acting Chief Judge to evaluate and decide whether the National Traffic Safety Institute should continue to be approved as a provider of Basic Driver School Services in the Second Judicial Circuit.
