ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 90-10

AMENDMENT

IN RE: Public Guardianship Office,  
Second Judicial Circuit

WHEREAS: Administrative Order No. 90-10, IN RE: Public Guardianship Office, Second Judicial Circuit, dated February 9, 1990, sets forth various policies and procedures for the operation of Public Guardian program; and

WHEREAS: There is a temporary need to allow a stay of time for filing certain reports and returns normally due in probate involving wards of the Public Guardian, IT IS THEREFORE

ORDERED that:


Administrative Order 90-10, IN RE: Public Guardianship Office, Second Judicial Circuit, dated February 9, 1991, is hereby amended by the creation of a new Section VI which shall read as follows:

"ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY STAY OF TIME FOR FILING OF CERTAIN REPORTS AND RETURNS OF PUBLIC GUARDIAN"

A. A stay of time in which to file any Six Months Report due under the Public Guardianship Act for the period of July 1, 1991 through November 30, 1991 is necessary, and, therefore, the Public Guardian is allowed a stay of ninety (90) days from the due date of the reports in question of any Six Months Report due during the period of July 1, 1991 through November 30, 1991.
