In RE: Religious Holiday - Yom Kippur

Whereas, Section 683.19, Florida Statutes, specifies that, " The Chief Judge of any judicial circuit is authorized to designate Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur as legal holidays for the courts within the judicial circuit. If the holidays are so designated, the courts in the judicial circuit may remain closed for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur, and those days will be holidays for those persons employed by the courts"; and


Whereas, Administrative Order 90-29, In Re: Religious Holidays - Yom Kippur, was entered on December 5, 1990 to provide a procedure for excusing attorneys and staff during the religious holiday of Yom Kippur; and

Whereas, the Chief Judge has designated both Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur as legal holidays in the 2nd Judicial Circuit, thus eliminating the need for the above referenced Administrative Order; it is therefore,

ORDERED THAT:

Administrative Order 90-29, in Re: Religious Holiday - Yom Kippur, entered on December 5, 1990, is hereby rescinded.
