**WHEREAS, this Administrative Order was entered on May 15, 1990 which required that legal memorandum and a proposed order accompany certain types of motions; and**


**WHEREAS, the goal of this Administrative Order, to improve efficiency in handling motions, appears to have not been achieved; and**
