IN RE: Circuit Court Judge Assignments - 2nd Judicial Circuit

Whereas, there is a need to update a provision of Administrative order 91-3 to clarify the use of County Judges when they are temporarily assigned to the Circuit Court bench, it is therefore,


ORDERED that:

Section VII.C of the above referenced Administrative Order is hereby amended to read as follows:

Paragraph C. - County Judge Back-Up Policy:

The County Judges assigned in Franklin, Gadsden, Jefferson, Leon and Wakulla are assigned in their respective counties to supplement and aide the Circuit Court Judges. County Judges may be assigned to handle contested dissolution and/or child support and enforcement cases only on a case by case basis pursuant to a specific order of the Chief Judge or, in emergencies, as specified by Administrative Order 91-04, In Re: Procedures for Emergency Hearings.
