ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 91- 8

IN RE: **SCHEDULING OF FIRST COURT APPEARANCE
FOR ALL DETAINEES OF LEON COUNTY JAIL**

Effective immediately, the following criteria will govern
the scheduling of the first court appearance for persons detained
in the Leon County Jail:

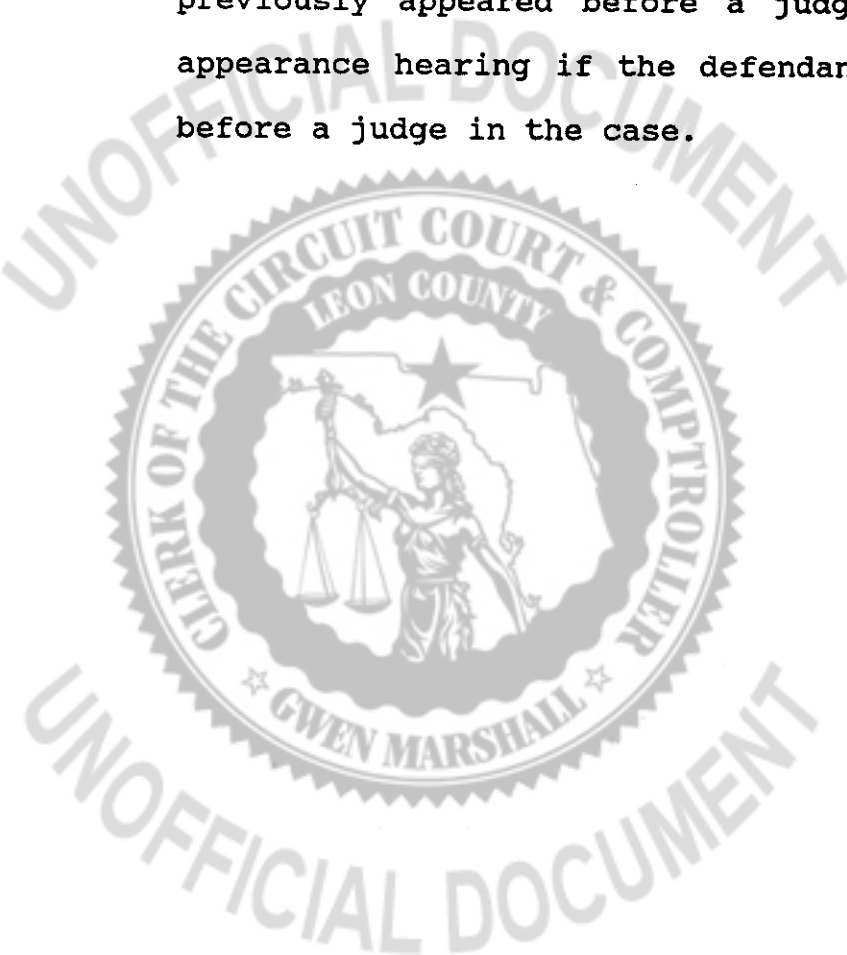
1. All on-view arrests, via probable cause or
warrant in misdemeanor, traffic, or felony cases: Schedule for next
first appearance hearing.

2. Violation of probation in traffic and misdemeanor
cases: Schedule for arraignment before the first appearance judge
on the next regular business day (i.e., excluding weekends and
holidays).

3. Violation of probation in felony cases: Schedule for
circuit court appearance on second regular business day after
arrest (i.e., excluding weekends and holidays).

4. Failure to appear or violation of release conditions
in misdemeanor and traffic cases (including violation of
probation): Schedule for the next first appearance hearing on
regular business day (i.e., excluding weekends and holidays),
denoting the appearance as an arraignment if the defendant has
previously appeared before a judge in the case or as a first
appearance hearing if the defendant has not previously appeared
before a judge in the case.


5. Failure to appear or violation of release conditions in felony or felony violation of probation cases: Schedule for arraignment in circuit court if defendant has previously appeared before a judge in the case, otherwise schedule for first appearance.

6. Violation of domestic injunction: Notify the office of the issuing judge and arrange for an appearance before that judge at the next available date.

7. Persons held on detainers or warrants from other jurisdictions: Schedule for next first appearance.

If there is any question or confusion concerning the scheduling of any person detained, contact the first appearance judge.
