ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #91-11

IN RE: County Court Administrative Orders

WHEREAS, numerous County Court Administrative Orders promulgated in each of the counties within the Second Judicial Circuit over the years and,

WHEREAS, there is a need to terminate those County Court Administrative Orders which are outdated or which have been superseded by statutory or rule changes; and,

WHEREAS, there is a need to develop a system to make officials in the respective counties and/or other interested parties aware of those County Administrative Orders that are currently active; it is therefore,

ORDERED THAT:

- 1) Effective December 1, 1991, all County Court Administrative Orders with the exception of those listed below are hereby terminated.

The following is a current list of County Court Administrative Orders which shall remain in effect:

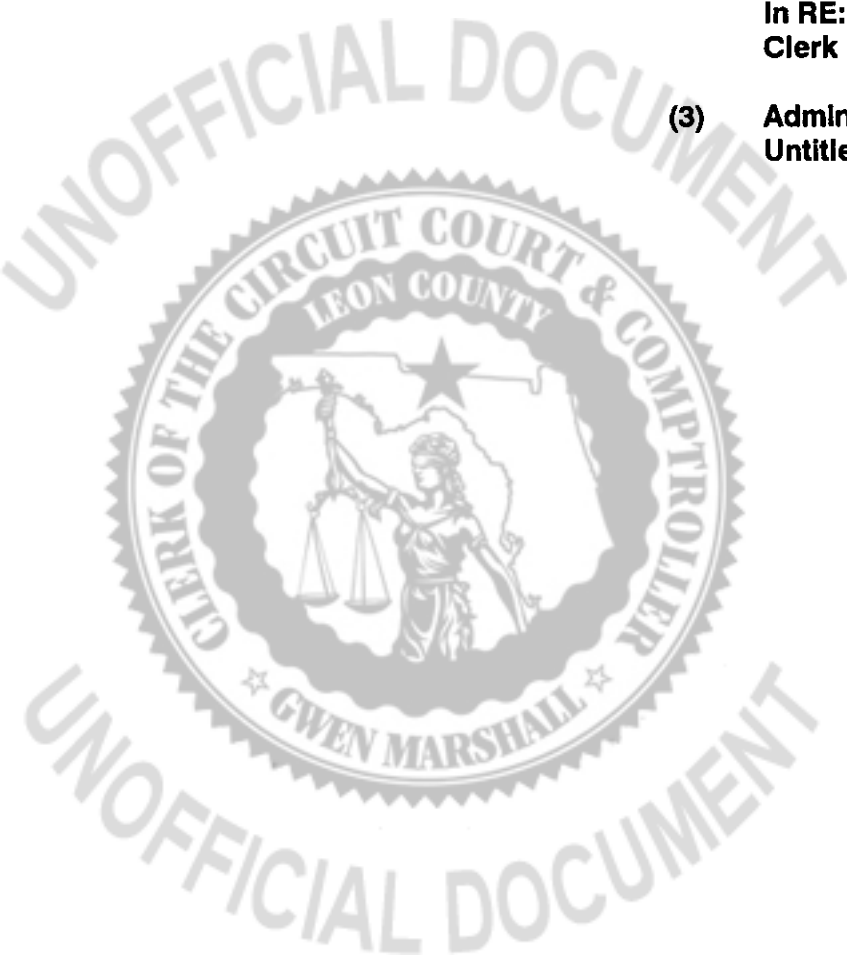

The Court Administrator shall also periodically disseminate a listing of active County Court Administrative Orders to County Court Judges in the Second Judicial Circuit, local officials and/or interested parties.
