
Whereas, the Judge responsible for Computer Planning and Coordination has requested that this assignment be changed, due to an extensive number of professional commitments in other areas; it is therefore

ORDERED THAT:

Administrative Order 93-07, IN RE: Circuit Court Judge Assignments - 2nd Judicial Circuit, dated July 1, 1993, is hereby amended by the creation of a new section VII-B that shall read as follows:

- B. Computer Planning and Coordination:
Judge George S. Reynolds, III is designated as the Computer Planning and Coordination Judge responsible for making recommendations to the Chief Judge on automation issues including computer hardware, software, budgeting and installation of such equipment. Judge Reynolds shall serve as a representative and spokesman for the judiciary on various committees in the automation area.
