1. All funds remaining in the county budget on December 31, 1972, allocated for the operation of the office of County Judge of Leon County shall be disbursed to the Clerk of the Circuit Court in equal monthly increments during the period January 1, 1973, ending September 30, 1973, to be used by the Clerk of the Circuit Court in the discharge of additional responsibilities of the Clerk as Clerk of the County Court.

2. It is the intent of this Order to facilitate the transition consequent upon the implementation of Const. Art. V as amended, and statutes and rules enacted and promulgated pursuant thereto, and to reduce administrative procedures as may be practical and feasible to do so.

3. Copies hereof shall be furnished to the Clerk and the Judges of the County Court of Leon County and the Clerk shall record this Order in the public records of the county.
