ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 73-32

This order is made for the purpose of implementing Article V of the Constitution to insure an orderly functioning of the Court of the County Judge in Wakulla and Franklin Counties realizing that each of these Counties have only one County Judge.

Therefore it is hereby ordered that in the event either of the County Judges of either of these Counties are absent or unavailable because of illness, assignment to duties elsewhere or otherwise that the Judge of the other County is authorized and assigned to perform the duties and judicial functions of the absent Judge. This order is not directive but is permissive and therefore no compensation for mileage or per diem is authorized.
