ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 73-44

IN RE: Uniform order setting pre-trial conferences in
civil cases pursuant to RCP 1.200 (b).

In accordance with the provision set forth in
RCP 1.200 (b) requiring orders setting pre-trial
conferences to be uniform throughout the territorial
jurisdiction of the court the following rule for the
Second Judicial Circuit is adopted, with the concurrence
of a majority of the circuit judges thereof:

1. Unless the parties or their counsel, with
the concurrence of the trial judge involved, shall
agree otherwise, an order setting a pre-trial conference
in a civil case shall be issued not less than twenty days
before such conference and shall be pursuant to announcement
of the Court to counsel at the calling of the calendar
or sounding of the docket at which time a trial date is
fixed. The trial judge setting the pre-trial conferences
as beforesaid shall cause the Order to be filed in the
cause with the Clerk, with copies to parties or their
counsel of record.

Nothing herein shall be construed as preventing any
stipulation or waiver by the parties that a pre-trial con-
ference be set otherwise than herein provided.
