ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 74-19

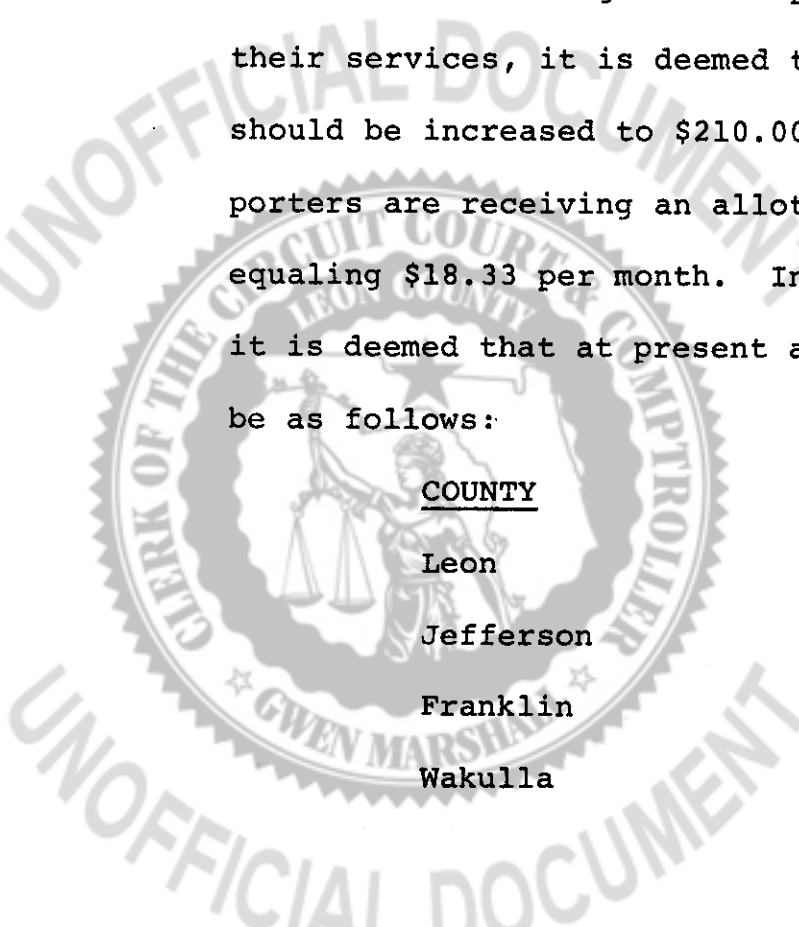
IN RE: Court Reporters' Expenses (Amendment to the Provision of Administrative Order No. 73-37)

RECORDED IN THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF LEON CO. FLA. IN THE BOOK & PAGE IND. JUN 4 2 46 PM '74 AT THE CLERK'S OFFICE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT IN TALLAHASSEE FLA. PAID BY HARTSFIELD

1. By Administrative Order No. 73-37, to which reference is herein made, the undersigned with the concurrence of the other Circuit Judges of the circuit made a finding that the Official Court Reporters who were subject to and assigned to duty in the counties of Leon, Franklin, Jefferson and Wakulla were justly in need of and deserve a supplement to the extent of \$125.00 per month in order to insure competent reporting in criminal matters in said several counties. It is now apparent that since the entry of said order the cost of living and of supplies has greatly increased and that the case loads of the respective counties are such that the services of Court Reporters are necessary to a much greater extent than in the past or that had been anticipated.

2. In view of the foregoing and of general economic conditions affecting Court Reporters and the expense of rendering their services, it is deemed that their compensation supplement should be increased to \$210.00 per month. Currently these reporters are receiving an allotment for supplies from Leon County equaling \$18.33 per month. In view of all of these circumstances it is deemed that at present a fair allotment by counties would be as follows:

| <u>COUNTY</u> | <u>PRO RATA OF SALARY SUPPLEMENT</u> |
|---------------|--------------------------------------|
| Leon          | \$165.00                             |
| Jefferson     | \$15.00                              |
| Franklin      | \$15.00                              |
| Wakulla       | \$15.00                              |



3. The above allotments are not strictly in proportion to population and each of the counties other than Leon will be paying the same amount even though there is some difference in their populations. However, it appears that the services of Court Reporters in the three smaller counties are about the same in time and frequency.

4. The reporters deemed to be entitled to such supplements are: Mrs. Carol Causseaux, Mrs. Jada Dolcater, Mrs. Betty Kirkland, Miss Frances Thigpen and Mrs. Loretta White.


5. Accordingly it is found and determined that the counties of Leon, Jefferson, Franklin and Wakulla are obligated to pay to each of the Official Court Reporters listed in the preceding paragraph the sum that is set forth in paragraph 2, commencing October 1, 1974.

6. I am authorized to state that each of the other Circuit Judges concur in this order.

7. All provisions of Administrative Order No. 73-37, except as herein modified, are by reference made a part hereof and shall remain in effect.

8. A signed copy of this order shall be furnished each Clerk of the Circuit Court in the counties involved and they shall cause it to be recorded in the appropriate records of their said counties.
