RE: Amendments to Administrative Order #75-1 to permit the Office of the State Attorney to appoint the Division of Family Services as a recipient of child support payments from the sheriff as the child receives Aid to Dependent Family Services.

1. Paragraph 6 of Administrative Order 75-1

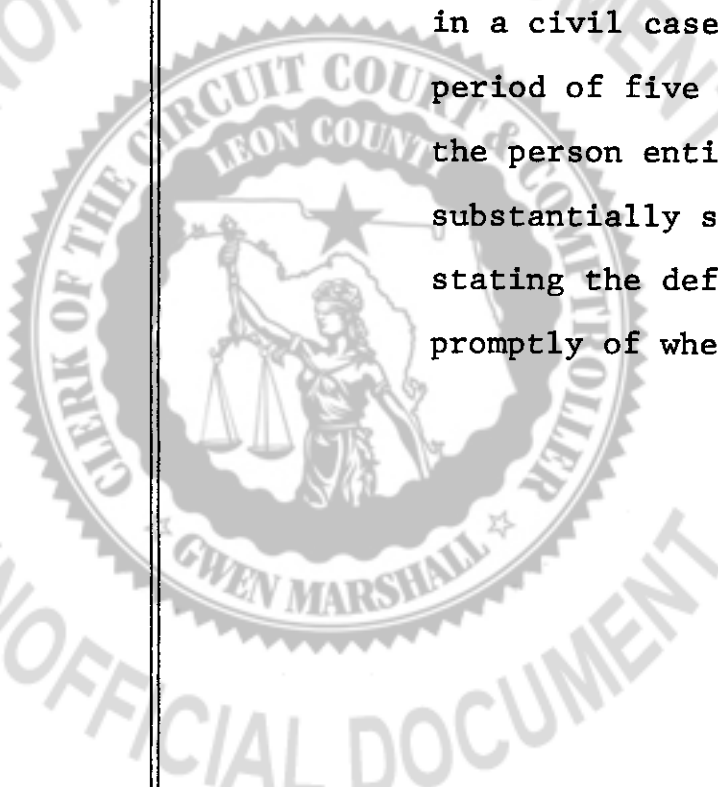
is amended to read:

On or before the fifth (5) working day following the receipt of such payment the amount of same less the fee above mentioned shall be mailed by regular mail to the person designated to receive same, addressed as shown in the Order or Judgment directing same or as furnished by the State Attorney. Whenever an order in either a criminal or civil case is made for the support of a child or children for whom payments are being made pursuant to law as Aid to Dependent Children through the Division of Family Services, then the Division of Family Services shall be the recipient of such support payments so long as said child or children shall receive such Aid to Dependent Children.

2. Paragraph 9 of Administrative Order 75-1 is

amended to read:


If any person shall fail to make a required payment in a civil case, and be in default thereof for a period of five (5) days the Sheriff shall mail to the person entitled to receive the payment a letter substantially set forth in Exhibit A attached, stating the default and requesting an expression promptly of whether enforcement is desired.



If the case is one in which the Division of Family Services is the payee, the original of the letter substantially set forth in Exhibit A attached shall be directed to the Division of Family Services with a copy to the State Attorney's Office. If the case is a criminal case, the State Attorney's Office shall be notified on a form, substantially as set forth in Exhibit A1 attached.

3. This Administrative Order shall go into effect July 1, 1975.
