ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 75-12

It has come to the attention of the office of the Chief Judge the need to clarify reporting requirements by Court Reporters or by mechanical devices. In compliance with Florida Rules of Court Procedure and Transition Rule 12 promulgated by the Florida Supreme Court the following rule shall govern the reporting of certain proceedings.

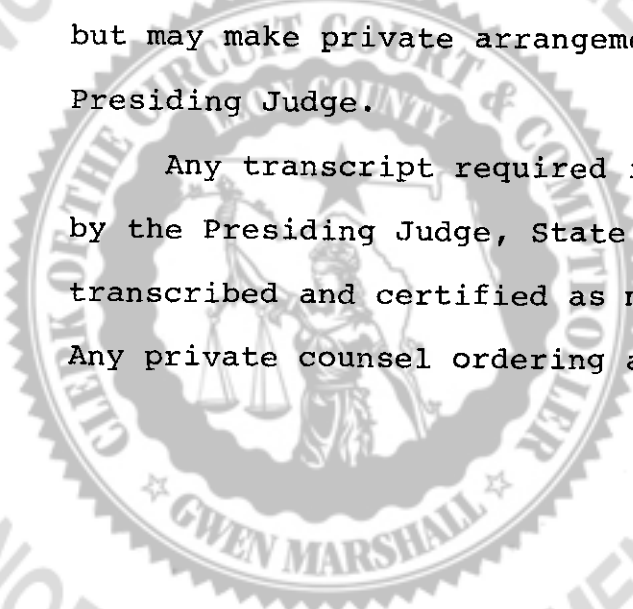
ACCORDINGLY, It is:

ADJUDGED that, all proceedings or matters in the Criminal and Juvenile Divisions of the Circuit Court of the Second Judicial Circuit shall be reported by a Court Reporter except matters in the Juvenile Division may be reported either by a Court Reporter or by mechanical device as provided in Juvenile Procedures, Rule 8.130. Any transcript required in any juvenile matter that has been mechanically reported and Ordered transcribed by the Presiding Judge, shall be transcribed by the Clerk of the Court and certified by the Clerk and Presiding Judge.

It is further Ordered that all proceedings in the County Courts of the Second Judicial Circuit shall be reported by mechanical device unless otherwise Ordered by the Presiding Judge. Such mechanical devices shall be operated by the Clerk of the Court or the Bailiff in attendance at the proceedings or such other person as the Presiding Judge may designate.

It is the sense of this Order that no party as of right may demand the services of an Official Court Reporter or Deputy Court Reporter, but may make private arrangements for such reporting if approved by the Presiding Judge.

Any transcript required in any County Court matter, if Ordered by the Presiding Judge, State Attorney or Public Defender, shall be transcribed and certified as may be directed by the Presiding Judge. Any private counsel ordering a transcript shall be responsible for



making the request to the Presiding Judge, and said Judge shall cause arrangements for same to be made.

It is further Ordered that any proceeding in the Traffic Division which is classified as a civil infraction and comes under the Civil Rules of Procedure shall not be required to be reported either by a Court Reporter or mechanical device. Any defendant requiring such proceeding to be recorded shall be responsible for any arrangements with the Court Reporter to report such proceedings.
