IN RE: Civil penalties to be assessed for traffic infractions: moving, non-moving, bicycles and pedestrian violations.

Because of the lack of uniformity in interpreting the Statutes as they relate to the moving, non-moving, bicycle and pedestrian civil traffic infractions a list of these violations are attached and made a part of this Order and are adopted for use in the Second Judicial Circuit. This list is suggested by the Traffic Court Review Committee and Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles, and was furnished to the undersigned by the Supreme Court Traffic Review Committee.

Section 318.18 of the Florida Statutes, 1974 Supplement, provides that the amount of civil penalty to be paid upon admitting the commission of a traffic infraction shall be \$25.00 for moving violations, \$15.00 for non-moving violations and \$5.00 for bicycle and pedestrian violations. Adoption of the attached list of violations will further the cause of uniformity in administering justice to the citizens of this State and those persons charged with traffic infractions.
