
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 77-9

IN RE: Rule 3.130 (b) (1) (FIRST APPEARANCE) FLORIDA RULES OF CRIMINAL  
PROCEDURE

This order supercedes Administrative Order Number 73-2 dated  
January 23, 1973.

In order to give some relief to the County Court Judges of all  
counties of the Second Judicial Circuit of weekend and Holiday first appear-  
ance duty, each County Judge in the Second Judicial Circuit, shall have the  
full authority of committing magistrates in each of the six counties to  
accomplish the requirement of Rule 3.130 (b) (1), FRCP, except, no County  
Judge shall sit in any county in which he is not qualified by law to sit,  
and where no request or prearranged agreement is entered into by the Judge  
or Judges requesting assistance in their respective counties.
