
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 77-32

It has come to the attention of the office of the Chief Judge the need to clarify reporting requirements in criminal matters by the Official Court Reporters of the Second Judicial Circuit. After consideration of the requirements and law for reporting such matters and the method employed for assignments of the Official Court Reporters it is, therefore,

ORDERED and ADJUDGED that all criminal matters, including the taking of criminal depositions, wherein the State Attorney, Public Defender, or Court appointed attorney has requested such matters to be reported shall be reported by an Official Court Reporter, or the Official Reporters duly appointed Deputy as provided for in Chapter 29 F. S., unless otherwise approved by the Presiding Judge. The Official Court Reporter shall be responsible for all billings for service to the County or State and any salaries or fees to be paid to their Deputy Reporter.

Further, it is ORDERED and ADJUDGED that all Juvenile Detention Hearings shall be mechanically recorded, and such mechanical device shall be operated by a person designated by the Presiding Judge. If any Detention Hearing matters need to be transcribed the Presiding Judge shall determine and appoint the person who will transcribe such proceedings.
