ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 77-42

RE: Use of rooms in Leon County Court House for taking of depositions limited to Official Court Reporters or their duly appointed Deputy Reporters of the Second Judicial Circuit.

It is made to appear that considerable confusion has arisen when depositions are set to be taken at the same place and time in the Leon County Court House by different persons serving as reporters. As only a few rooms are suitable and available for such use, it is deemed necessary to limit their use for the purpose of depositions to the Official Court Reporters or their duly appointed Deputy Reporters designated for the Second Judicial Circuit, and they are required to check with each other to avoid conflicting settings.

Nothing herein pertains to hearings, trials, or other procedures before a judge or a special master, nor to the use of the hearing room of a judge who has consented to such use.


