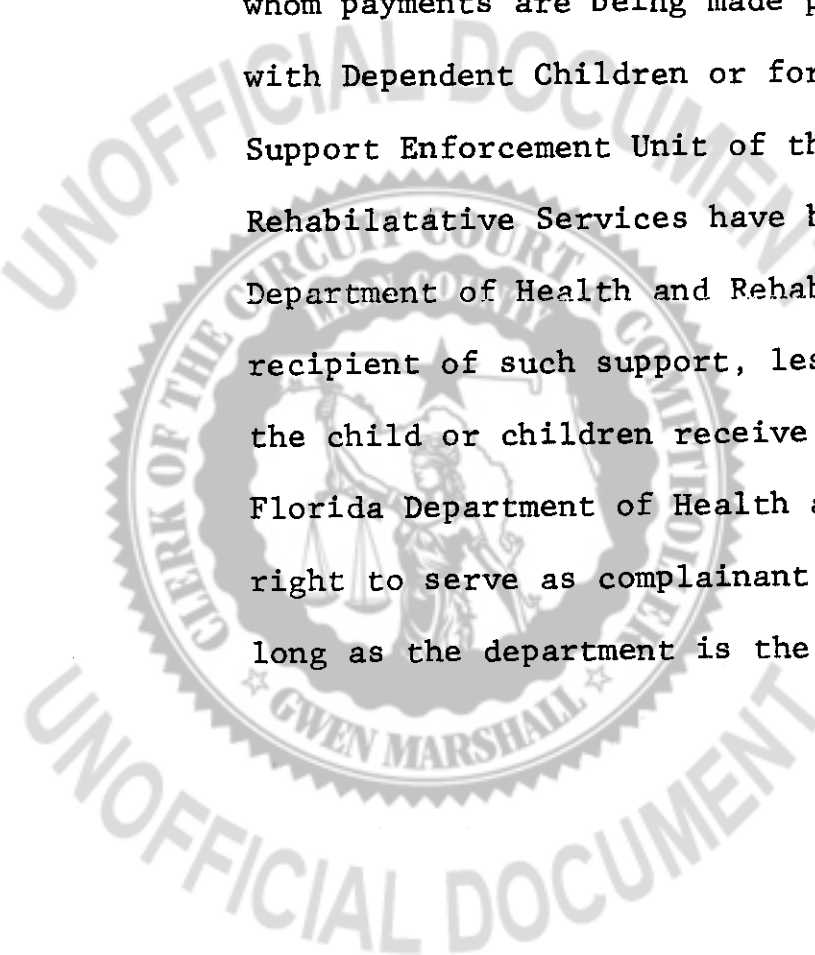

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 78-11


RE: Administrative Order to appoint the Florida Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services as a recipient of child support payments paid to the Sheriff or Clerk of the Circuit Court in and for each county of this circuit for so long as the child receives Aid to Families with Dependent Children or is otherwise eligible for the services of the Child Support Enforcement Unit of the Florida Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services

Pursuant to authority conferred by Chapters 88 and 742, and Section 61.181, Florida Statutes (1975) and Section 409.2554 et seq., Florida Statutes 1976 Supplement, and by Rule 1.611(b), FRCP, the Clerk of the Circuit Court or the Sheriff, on or before the fifth (5th) working day or the last day of the month, which ever is later, following the receipt of payment of child support, shall mail, the amount of same, less the service fee, if any, by regular mail to the person designated to receive same, addressed as shown in the Order or Judgment directing same, or as furnished by the State Attorney. Whenever an order in either criminal or civil case is made for the support of a child or children for whom payments are being made pursuant to law as Aid to Families with Dependent Children or for whom the Services of the Child Support Enforcement Unit of the Florida Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services have been retained, the Florida Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services shall be the recipient of such support, less the service fee, for so long as the child or children receive such aid or services. The Florida Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services have the right to serve as complainant in any enforcement proceeding so long as the department is the obligee of such support.



This Administrative Order shall go into effect immediately, and any action heretofore taken consistent herewith is hereby ratified and approved.
