
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 79-56

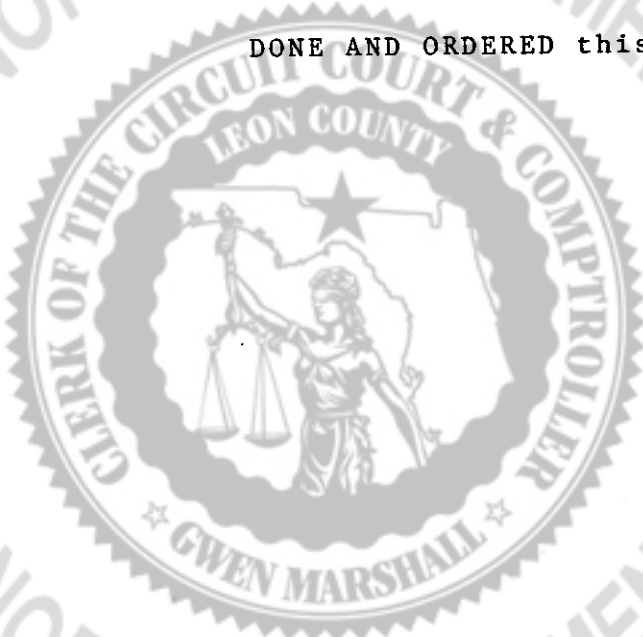
RE: Jury Selection by Clerks of Court, Second Judicial Circuit

Pursuant to Chapter 79-235, Laws of Florida, Acts of 1979, which becomes effective on January 1, 1980, and amends Section 40.02, Florida Statutes, each Clerk of the Court of the Second Judicial Circuit is hereby directed to prepare a list of jurors in each of their respective counties during the first week in January of each year or as soon thereafter as practicable, to be used as prospective jurors during each calendar year. The Clerk of Court shall randomly select a sufficient number of names with the addresses from the list of persons who are qualified to serve as jurors under the provisions of Florida Statutes 40.01, as amended by Chapter 79-235, Laws of Florida, and to generate a list of not less than 250 persons to serve as jurors, which list shall be signed and verified by the Clerk of Court as having been selected as aforesaid.

This Order shall become effective on January 1, 1980, and shall be a continuous order, unless otherwise withdrawn, superseded or modified by the Chief Judge of the Second Judicial Circuit, or unless otherwise modified or superseded by some act of law.
