
AMENDED

UPON the request of the State Attorney's Office  
the Administrative Orders of September 17, 1974 and March 7,  
1978, are hereby set aside. The Clerk of the Leon County  
Court is no longer authorized to accept payments of court  
cost or restitution on worthless checks at the counter or  
to dismiss such checks as been the practice in the past.

THE STATE ATTORNEY'S OFFICE now has a precharge  
interventions method of collection and the necessity for  
the Clerks having to perform that function is no longer  
necessary.
