RE: Committee to Study Alternatives for Court Proceedings.

Because of the continuing need to find alternatives and solutions to the growing caseloads in the courts and to assist the courts in resolving matters more expediently, I hereby appoint a committee to study and make recommendations in the following areas.

Study mediation alternatives involving domestic matters, minor misdemeanors, and citizen disputes not involving extensive property and domestic relations.

This committee shall be comprised of:

- Tim Harley, State Attorney's Office
- Charles Broome, State Attorney's Office
- Mike Coyne, Public Defender's Office
- J. Worth Owen, Attorney
- Jon Rossman, Governor's Office

The committee is charged with the responsibility of making any recommendations with regard to needs, structure of any recommended program, staffing and the funding of such programs.

The committee shall report its findings to the Office of the Chief Judge of the Second Judicial Circuit.
