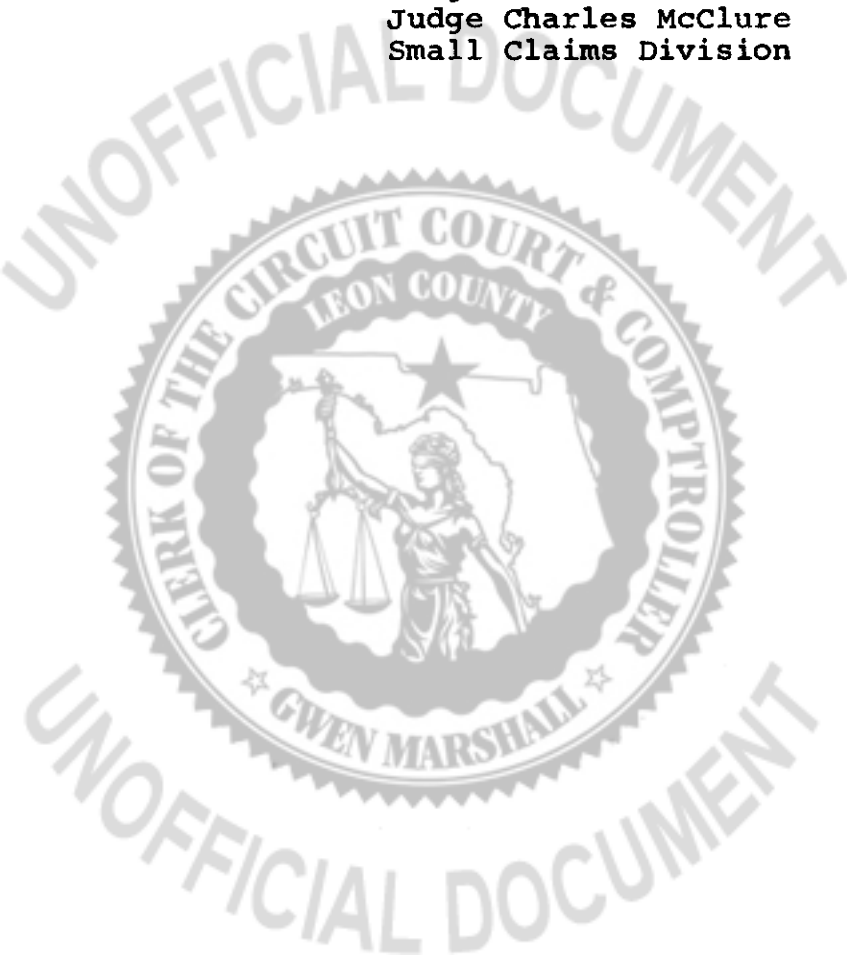
Subject to the approval of the Chief Judge and

RULE 7.- SETTLEMENTS

Rule 7 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Where possible in civil or criminal cases a settlement or disposition of the case shall be immediately communicated to the Clerk and it shall be the responsibility of the Clerk to notify the State in criminal cases and the defendant, or his attorney, that the case has been settled; and it shall then be the responsibility of the State or the defendant, or his attorney, to notify their witnesses of the settlement of the case and that their presence will not be needed. It shall then be the responsibility of the Clerk in civil cases to notify the parties, or their attorneys, and it shall then become the responsibility of the parties, or their attorneys, to notify their witnesses that their appearance is not necessary."
